## 2009 Summer PHRF Series

### Notice of Race

3/1/2009

#### Format

11 Sundays between May 31, and August 30, 2009.  
One or two races per day, depending on conditions.

#### Rules

Races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. YRA of LIS PHRF weight limits will apply. Advertising will be limited to Category A under rule 79 and Appendix 1.

#### Eligibility

Boats with a current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate, rating less than 228.

#### Divisions

There will be two spinnaker divisions and one non-spinnaker division ("JAM"). Division 1 for ratings 122 and lower, Division 2 for ratings 123-228, and Division 3 for non-spinnaker. Scratch sheets will be available at CPYC, at [www.cedarpointyc.org](http://www.cedarpointyc.org). A boat may enter Division 3 as well as Division 1 or 2. However, on any race day a boat may race only in a single division.

#### Entries

The Entry Form and a current YRA of LIS PHRF Certificate must be received by the Wednesday preceding the first race entered. The entry fee for non-CPYC members is \$100. (The entry fee for CPYC Members is included in Fleet dues.) Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of CPYC. #### Schedule

Spinnaker divisions will sail 1 or 2 races each day, at the sole discretion of the race committee; JAM boats will sail 1 race each day.

The first warning is scheduled for 1300 each day.

#### Courses

Typically windward / leeward (spinnaker) and triangle variations (JAM).

#### Racing Area

Approximately 1 - 3 miles southeast of bouy "3" Fl G 4 s (the "Bug Light") at the mouth of Saugatuck Harbor.

#### Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available in the breezeway at CPYC and/or on the Club website. A limited number may be available from the Race Committee on the water.

#### Equipment

Boats shall carry all equipment required by USCG regulations and a radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channel 78.

#### Qualification

A boat must participate in 50% (rounded up) of the races sailed in a division. Races on May 31, June 14, July 26 and August 30 are also qualifiers for YRA-LIS season trophies and their results will be reported to YRA-LIS.

#### Scoring

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her best qualifying race scores.

#### Prizes

Daily prizes will be awarded at the CPYC clubhouse, to the top 3 boats in each division after the day's racing. Series prizes will be awarded and presented at the CPYC Awards Dinner.

#### Hospitality

Following each day's racing, beer and soft drinks will be provided.
