Eligibility Radial and Standard Rigs, any age, all are welcome to join! Must be able to swim and right a capsized.

Rules Races will be governed by the RRS, the Appendices, this NOR and the Sailing Instructions. All competitors shall conform to rules set by the International Laser Class Association except that Intensity sails may be used as an alternative to the official Laser class sails in local fleet racing only as a test of their suitability for inclusion in our program longer term. **Note that official Laser Class sails are required on any Regatta days. Wetsuit or drysuit and USCG PFD required.**

All competitors must schedule their RC duty by their 1st day of sailing or they will not be scored until they do and they must fulfill their duty each season to qualify and continue to sail.

In the event of a disagreement between any of the documents cited above, this NOR shall prevail over the others and the Sailing Instructions shall prevail over this NOR.

Directions I-95 exit 17, turn right at end of ramp, 1 mile turn left onto Duck Pond Road, 1/4 mile turn left onto Harbor Road, 1/2 mile to wooden bridge, 3rd right, 1st left. SPEED LIMIT 15 after bridge. Trucks, Trailers & Car-top Lasers: **DO NOT CROSS WOODEN BRIDGE!** Instead, right on Canal Road, left at end, 2nd left, 1st right CPYC shares Bluff Point in a residential neighborhood populated by many young children and pedestrians. Please be mindful of the 15 mph speed limit and stop signs on Saugatuck Island.

WAI VER AND RELEASE - In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I hereby agree that the safety of my boat and her crew, including the decision whether or not to wear life jackets, and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race, is my responsibility and not that of any person sponsoring or undertaking such race. I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, and damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Cedar Point Yacht Club, its officers, governors, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns.

I also understand that I am expected to sign-up and serve on the Race Committee, and if I fail to perform my Race Committee duties on my assigned day (without arranging for substitution by another registered competitor, including getting the approval of RC Chair or Fleet Captain) that I will be scored as DSQ for each race sailed that day. I understand that to qualify for season prizes, I must participate in at least 50% of the races or days sailed for the season.

I understand that Lasers may only be left on Club property as outlined on the next page (Titled 'Additional Information') and I understand that Lasers found without a CPYC-issued name label or left on CPYC property outside of the period of time for which storage has been paid may be padlocked, impounded or seized and subject to a late fee and penalty in addition to any storage fees assessed.

I agree to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the other rules as set out in the NOR. I have read and understand Fundamental Rules 1 through 5. I understand that abusive language directed at another competitor or at a race official may result in penalties under rules 2 or 69.1(a).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Boat Storage - Winter Members note that included in your Series or Season entry fee is the privilege of storing your boat in the drystall at CPYC for the duration of the Series that you have paid for. This includes the break between the Fall and Spring Series **only** if you have paid for both series (full Season).

Full-Year CPYC Members note that the Club charges a storage fee which is NOT included in the Frostbite entry fee to the owner of every Laser left at the Club at any time between November 15 and April 15. ***If you will be leaving your boat at the Club overnight at any point during this period of time, you must either prepay this fee with your entry (preferred) or submit a drystall storage application along with a check for storage directly to the Club Bookkeeper prior to leaving your boat at the Club.***

CPYC will charge late fees to the owners or charterers of boats that are not registered and paid for the current Frostbite Series, or stored or left at the Club outside of the period for which storage has been paid. There will be a one-week grace period before and after each Series, although boats ***registered and paid*** for the Fall Series or full Season may be brought to the Club anytime after Labor Day. Boats paid for the Spring Series or full Season, intending to race on Memorial Day weekend, ***must make arrangements with*** the Fleet Captain to be left at the Club without charge until that race date. To remain after the grace period, boat owners ***must*** apply to CPYC and pay for summer or winter storage at the published rates.

Boats brought to CPYC must be registered with the staff upon arrival. The Club is staffed seven days a week from 9 to 5. A label with your name will be printed that must be applied to the transom of your boat so that it may be readily identified. If it is not possible to check-in in person, you must make other arrangements with the staff within 24 hours of the arrival or your boat to avoid late fees. The Club phone number is 203-226-7411.

Please Note: Your Laser hull, your dolly and your cover ***must*** be prominently labeled with ***both*** your name and your sail number prior to being left at the Club.

Regatta scoring – The Fall and Spring Regattas will each count in the scoring as a regular day of the Series and Season, with all competitors counted.
