### Notice of Race & Addendum to Sailing Instructions

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Sailing Instructions of Cedar Point YC will apply as modified by this addendum.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 The rules of the J70 Class Association, Atlantic Class Association, International Star Class Yacht Racing Association, Thistle Class Association, International Lightning Class Association, and Flying Scot Sailing Association will apply to the appropriate classes.
- 1.5 Racing rule 26 will be changed to allow 5 minute or 3 minute sequences. Racing rules A4 and A5 will be changed to score boats DNS when starting 4 minutes after the signal. Racing rule 33 will be changed to allow for fixed marks. Racing rules 35, 63.1 A4, and A5 will be changed for TLE scoring. Racing rule 61.1(a) is changed for protest filings. Racing rule 60.1(a) will be changed for disqualifications. Racing rule A4.1 will be changed for check-in procedure. The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.6 This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions may be modified by the Cedar Point Fleet-Specific Addenda to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. If no applicable modification exists in the Fleet-Specific Addenda, then this Notice of Race shall serve as the governing document.
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

The races, Cup Weekends and Season Series are open to all boats of the J/70, Atlantic, Star, Thistle, Lightning, and Flying Scot classes owned by current members in good standing of Cedar Point Yacht Club, their guests, members or guests using club or fleet owned boats and guests of the fleets.

#### **DIVISIONS**

All boats shall race in the divisions specified by their class.

**4 FEE**

There is NO entry fee for CPYC members; it is included in your CPYC dues.

**5 QUALIFICATION**

- 5.1 A Boat must start at least 50% of the total number of races completed in her division to qualify for season series scoring in that division.
- 5.2 Qualification for Cup Weekends will require sailing on the “cook-out day” of the Cup Weekend.
- 5.3 Qualification rules may be modified by the Cedar Point Yacht Club Fleet-Specific Addenda to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

**7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available by Friday May 20, 2016, in the Cedar Point Yacht Club clubhouse breezeway and on the Cedar Point website, [www.cedarpointyc.org](http://www.cedarpointyc.org). There may be a limited supply available on the race committee boat.

**8 VENUE**

Starting area will be southeast of the mouth of the Saugatuck River.

**9 COURSES**

The courses and marks will be defined by the CPYC Sailing Instructions.

**10 SCORING**

10.1 The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the racing rules, will apply to the Saturday/Sunday Racing, Cup Weekends and the Season Series. A minimum of one race shall be completed to constitute a race day, Cup Weekend or Season Series.

10.2 Scoring rules may be modified by the Cedar Point Yacht Club Fleet-Specific Addenda to the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

**11 RADIO COMMUNICATION AND EQUIPMENT**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**12 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: CPYC daily prizes will be awarded on Saturday and Sunday races for the top three finishers in each class. On Cup Weekends, CPYC weekend prizes will only be awarded for the top three finishers based on scoring for the Cup Weekend. Season prizes for each fleet will be determined in accordance with the Cedar Point Trophy Policy, outlined below:

**13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**14 INSURANCE**

It is the responsibility of each owner to have proper insurance coverage including third party liability insurance. Skippers are reminded that they may be personally liable for damages resulting from contact between boats or race committee vessel from the time they leave the dock until they return to the dock.

**15 HOSPITALITY**

Limited beverages may be provided on the CPYC upper deck after the completion of racing.

**16 DOCKAGE**

A limited amount of dock space may be available for visiting yachts for temporary tie up. Please call the club on VHF CH. 78 to request dockage.
