ELIGIBILITY: Radial and Standard Rigs, any age, all are welcome to join - Must be able to swim and right a capsized.

RULES: Races will be governed by the RRS, the Appendices, this NOR and the Laser Sailing Instructions. All competitors shall conform to rules set by the International Laser Class Association except Intensity Sails may be used for Non-Class Racing. Intensity Sails are not permitted for District 7 Laser Regattas. A Wetsuit or Drysuit and USCG Type III PFD are required at all times. All competitors must schedule their RC duty date or they will not be scored until they do. Competitors must fulfill their duty each season to qualify and continue to sail. In the event of a disagreement between any of the documents cited above, this NOR shall prevail over the others and the Sailing Instructions shall prevail over this NOR.

Winter Members - signed up for the Fall and spring series - may keep their boats at Cedar Point YC for the Winter, single series registrants may only keep their boat at Cedar Point YC for the duration of the series registered.*

Please notify in advance Tim and/or the fleet captains if you cannot make your RC date.

Fall/Spring Season: 1st-3rd Standard and Radial fleets, top participant.
Robert B. Larson perpetual trophy to full winter season winner.
Must participate in 50% of races or 50% of day's to qualify for season.

WAIVER AND RELEASE - In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I hereby agree that the safety of my boat and her crew, including the decision whether or not to wear life jackets, and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race, is my responsibility and not that of any person sponsoring or undertaking such race. I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, and damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Cedar Point Yacht Club, its officers, governors, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns. I also understand that I am expected to sign-up and serve on the Race Committee, and if I fail to perform my Race Committee duties on my assigned day (without arranging for substitution by another registered competitor, including getting the approval of RC Chair or Fleet Captain) that I will be scored as DSQ for each race sailed that day. I understand that to qualify for season prizes, I must participate in at least 50% of the races or days sailed for the season. I understand that Lasers may only be left on Club property as outlined on the next page (Titled 'Additional Information') and I understand that Lasers found without a CPYC-issued name label or left on CPYC property outside of the period of time for which storage has been paid may be padlocked, impounded or seized and subject to a late fee and penalty in addition to any storage fees assessed. I agree to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the other rules as set out in the NOR. I have read and understand Fundamental Rules of Racing 1 through 5. I understand that abusive language directed at another competitor or at a race official may result in penalties under rules 2 or 69.1(a).

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Laser Additional Information

Boat Storage:

Winter Members note that included in your Series or Season entry fee is the privilege of storing your boat in the drystall at Cedar Point YC for the duration of the Series that you have paid for. This includes the break between the Fall and Spring Series only if you have paid for both series (Full Season). Full-Year Cedar Point YC Members note that the Club charges a storage fee that is included in the Frostbite entry fee for boats stored between November 15 and April 15.

CPYC will charge late fees to the owners or charterers of boats that are not registered and paid in full for the current Laser Series, or stored or left at the Club outside of the period for which storage has been paid. There will be a one-week grace period before and after each Series, although boats registered and paid for the Fall Series or full Season may be brought to the Club anytime after Labor Day.

Boats paid for the Spring Series or full Season, intending to race on Memorial Day weekend, must make arrangements with the Fleet Captain to be left at the Club without charge until that race date. To remain after the grace period, boat owners must apply to Cedar Point YC and pay for summer or winter storage at the published rates. Non-members may apply for rack storage in the summer but may not sail their boat at Cedar Point during that time. Members may apply for summer drystall storage or rack storage.

Boats brought to Cedar Point YC should be registered with the dock staff upon arrival. The Club is staffed seven days a week from 9 to 5. A label with your name will be printed that must be applied to the transom of your boat so that it may be readily identified. If it is not possible to check-in in person, you must make other arrangements with the staff within 24 hours of the arrival or your boat to avoid late fees.

Please Note: Your Laser hull, your dolly and your cover must be prominently labeled with both your name and your sail number prior to being left at the Club. It is suggested that all of your gear has your name on it.

Regatta scoring: The Fall and Spring Regattas will each count in the scoring as a regular day of the Series and Season, with all competitors counted.
