### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### **1. RULES:**

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association(ISCYRA), as may be modified by this Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions, and subsequent amendments. The Organizing Authority is Cedar Point Yacht Club. The host fleet is Central Long Island Sound Star Fleet (CLIS) .

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY:**

Entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form at registration on Saturday September 8, 2018.

#### **3. ENTRY FEE:**

The entry fee of \$10 includes boat & trailer parking, launching and hauling. An optional fee of an additional \$80 includes dinner for Skipper and Crew on Saturday evening to be held on the upper deck of the club house. Additional invitations to the Saturday night dinner will be available at a cost of \$30.00 per person at registration.

The entry fee is due at registration on September 8, 2018. Checks should be made to "Central Long Island Sound Fleet".

#### **4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

Up to three races may be sailed each day but no race will be started after 1430 on Sunday.

#### **5. DISCLAIMER:**

The Organizing Authority will require each competitor to sign a waiver of loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of Cedar Point Yacht Club. The Organizing Authority, its members, employees, governors and/or agents and CLIS will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

#### **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

#### **9. RACING AREA:**

The racing area will be Long Island Sound approximately 1-3 miles southeast of the mouth of the Saugatuck River.

#### **10. COURSES AND PROCEDURES:**

Courses and procedures will be according to RULES OF THE ISCYRA rule 34, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

#### **11. SCORING:**

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A, will apply, except there will be no throw-out unless five races are completed. Five races are scheduled. Three completed races constitute a series.

## **12. PRIZES:**

The Bedford Pitcher perpetual trophy will be awarded to the overall winner.

Take-home prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing 1 through 3.

## **13. HOUSING:**

Housing with local yachtsmen will be provided if possible. Please contact the Regatta Chairman.

## **Directions to Cedar Point Yacht Club**

### **From either North or South**

Connecticut Turnpike (I-95) to exit 17 (Westport). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Route 136. Go about 1.5 miles on Route 136. Turn left on Duck Pond Road. Take your first left on Harbor Road. Follow Harbor Road to the stop sign before the one-way bridge. After crossing the bridge take the first right then the first left onto Cross Way. This will take you to the club: One Bluff Point, Westport, CT 06880

CPYC shares Saugatuck Island with a residential neighborhood that includes many young children, bicyclists and pedestrians so please be mindful of the 15 mph speed limit on Saugatuck Island and obey all stop signs.
