Eligibility Everyone is welcome to join us! Must be able to sail and recover from a capsized.

Rules The frostbite fleet series shall be sailed in "Lasers". Hence, the laser class rules shall be used in the "spirit of sportsmanship", but not as the law. Therefore, class membership is not required, but strongly encouraged so members can participate in the Spring Regatta which is an open laser class event. Wetsuit or drysuit required - NO exceptions. Life vest must be worn at ALL times.. One week of Race Committee duty is required for all and your registration is not complete until you have signed-up for RC. After two weeks RC will be assigned.

Sails Standard and Radials may use North, Hyde or Intensity sails.

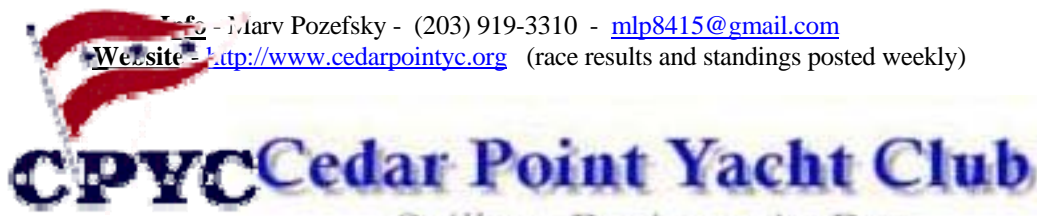
\$25 daily fee, applicable to full Series. To sail more than twice, must register for Series.

WAIVER AND RELEASE - In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I hereby agree that the safety of my boat and her crew, including the decision whether or not to wear life jackets, and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race, is my responsibility and not that of any person sponsoring or undertaking such race. I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, or damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Cedar Point Yacht Club, its officers, governors, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns.

I also understand that I am expected to sign-up and serve on the Race Committee, and if I fail to perform my Race Committee duties on my assigned day (without arranging for substitution by another registered competitor) that I will be scored as DSQ for each race sailed that day. I understand that to qualify for season prizes, I must participate in at least 50% of the races sailed for the season.

I understand that Lasers may be brought into the Laser area of the dry stall starting March 5, only during 9am-5pm any day. The person bringing in a Laser must register with the staff, who will give them a label with their name on it, which must be immediately put on the stern of the boat. I understand that Lasers found without a CPYC-issued name label may be padlocked and subject to a late fee in addition to any storage fees assessed. I understand that owners of Lasers on CPYC property after May 15th, who have not registered and paid for the frostbiting series, will be charged for winter storage.

I agree to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing. I have read and understand Fundamental Rules 1 through 5. I understand that abusive language directed at another competitor or at a race official may result in penalties under rules 2 or 69.1(a).

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Boat Storage - Winter Members note that included in your Series or Season entry fee is the privilege of storing your boat in the dry stall at CPYC for the duration of the Series that you have paid for. This includes the break between the Fall and Spring Series only if you have paid for both (full Season).

Full-year CPYC members note that the Club will charge a storage fee which is **NOT** included in the Frostbite entry fee, to the owner of any Laser at the Club between November 15 and April 15.

CPYC will charge late fees to the owners or charterers of boats that are not registered and paid for the current Frostbite Series, or stored or left at the Club outside of the period for which storage has been paid. There will be a one-week grace period before and after each Series, although boats registered and paid for the Fall Series or full Season may be brought to the Club anytime after Labor Day. Boats paid for the Spring Series or full Season, intending to race on Memorial Day weekend, may make arrangements with the Fleet Captain to be left at the Club without charge until that race date. To remain after the grace period, boat owners **MUST** apply to CPYC and pay for summer or winter storage at the published rates.

Boats brought to CPYC must be registered with the staff upon arrival. The Club is staffed seven days a week from 9 to 5. A label with your name will be printed that must be applied to the transom of your boat so that it may be readily identified, you will also be issued a winter storage sticker from Cedar Point that **MUST** be displayed on the transom. Any boat found on the property after November 26 without a CPYC sticker will not be scored for the season. If it is not possible to check-in in person, you must make other arrangements with the staff within 24 hours of the arrival or your boat, to avoid late fees. The Club phone number is 203-226-7411.

Regatta scoring – The Spring Regatta will NOT count in the scoring as a regular day of the Series and Season, with all competitors counted.

Sail Amendment: For the Spring 2011 series Standard and Radial boats have the option of using North, Hyde or Intensity sails.

Club Members with children (under 12) may have their children sail for Free. The 4,7 rigs will start with the radial fleet.

Prizes - Daily first place glass. (Winner to tell how he/she did it, in brief post-race chalk talk.)
Season 1-5, top Apprentice, Master, Grandmaster, Radial, Woman, and Junior.
Must participate in 50% of races to qualify for season. All qualifiers receive a prize.
