Eligibility Rules

Everyone, of any age, is welcome to join us! Must be able to sail and recover from a capsized. Races will be governed by the rules as defined in rules 1-84 and 89-91, plus the Appendices and Definitions, of "The Racing Rules of Sailing" and by the Sailing Instructions. The racing shall be conducted in boats manufactured, equipped, and rigged in conformity with the rules of the International Laser Class Association, except that Intensity sails may be used as alternatives to the official Laser class sails (unless otherwise stated). Wetsuit or drysuit required - no exceptions. USCG approved PFD must be worn. One day of Race Committee duty is required for all and your registration is not complete until you have signed-up for RC.

I-95 exit 17, turn right at end of ramp, 1 mile turn left onto Duck Pond Road, 1/4 mile turn left onto Harbor Road, 1/2 mile to wooden bridge, 3rd right, 1st left. **SPEED LIMIT 15** after bridge. **Trucks, Trailers & Car-top Lasers: DO NOT CROSS WOODEN BRIDGE!** Instead, right on Canal Road, left at end, 2nd left, 1st right CPYC shares Bluff Point in a residential neighborhood populated by many young children and pedestrians. Please be mindful of the 15 mph speed limit and stop signs on Saugatuck Island. The added minute or two will be safer, enhance your driving pleasure and do much to benefit our relations with local residents.

WAIVER AND RELEASE - In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I hereby agree that the safety of my boat and her crew, including the decision whether or not to wear life jackets, and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race, is my responsibility and not that of any person sponsoring or undertaking such race. I hereby forever and irrevocably waive, release and discharge any and all claims, liability, loss, or damages, including but not limited to claims for property damage, personal injury or death, which I may have or in the future acquire against Cedar Point Yacht Club, its officers, governors, members, employees, volunteers or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in any race or other activity sponsored or undertaken by any of them, even though such liability may arise out of their negligence or carelessness. I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailboat racing, and that participants in sailboat racing occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage as a consequence, and I knowingly assume all of the risks of sailboat racing. I agree that this waiver is binding on my heirs, representatives, successors and assigns.

I also understand that I am expected to sign-up and serve on the Race Committee, and if I fail to perform my Race Committee duties on my assigned day (without arranging for substitution by another registered competitor) that I will be scored as DSQ for each race sailed that day. I understand that to qualify for season prizes, I must participate in at least 50% of the races sailed for the season.

I understand that Lasers may be brought into the Laser area of the drystall starting September 10, only during 9am-5pm any day. The person bringing in a Laser must register with the staff, who will give them a label with their name on it, which must be immediately put on the stern of the boat. I understand that Lasers found without a CPYC-issued name label may be padlocked and subject to a late fee in addition to any storage fees assessed. I understand that owners of Lasers on CPYC property after November 15th, who have not registered and paid for the frostbiting series, will be charged for winter storage.

I agree to abide by the Racing Rules of Sailing. I have read and understand Fundamental Rules 1 through 5. I understand that abusive language directed at another competitor or at a race official may result in penalties under rules 2 or 69.1(a).

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Boat Storage - Winter Members note that included in your Series or Season entry fee is the privilege of storing your boat in the drystack at CPYC for the duration of the Series that you have paid for. This includes the break between the Fall and Spring Series only if you have paid for both (full Season).

Full-year CPYC members note that the Club will charge a storage fee (price is listed in the Club Bulletin), which is NOT included in the Frostbite entry fee, to the owner of any Laser at the Club between November 15 and April 15.

CPYC will charge late fees to the owners or charterers of boats that are not registered and paid for the current Frostbite Series, or stored or left at the Club outside of the period for which storage has been paid. There will be a one-week grace period before and after each Series, although boats registered and paid for the Fall Series or full Season may be brought to the Club anytime after Labor Day. Boats paid for the Spring Series or full Season, intending to race on Memorial Day weekend, may make arrangements with the Fleet Captain to be left at the Club without charge until that race date. To remain after the grace period, boat owners MUST apply to CPYC and pay for summer or winter storage at the published rates.

Boats brought to CPYC must be registered with the staff upon arrival. The Club is staffed seven days a week from 9 to 5. A label with your name will be printed that must be applied to the transom of your boat so that it may be readily identified. If it is not possible to check-in in person, you must make other arrangements with the staff within 24 hours of the arrival of your boat, to avoid late fees. The Club phone number is 203-226-7411.

Regatta scoring – The November 3rd Regatta will count in the scoring as a regular day of the Series and Season, with all competitors counted.
